Establishing water rates is complex and highly regulated, and requires gathering extensive data to determine an appropriate rate structure. It's been several years since Brea last completed a comprehensive water study to determine the costs of delivering water. The goal of the upcoming rate and fee study is to ensure that the revenues cover the cost of services, meet the debt coverage and reserve requirements, and provides revenue for future capital improvement projects.
