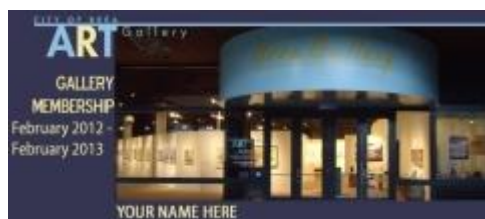
COURSE #8414: Flowers & flower arrangements Apr 15, Apr 22, Apr 29 1:00pm - 3:00pm, Sun
