

## BUSINESSES ALLOWED TO RE-OPEN IN ORANGE COUNTY

---

The City of Brea continues to follow the State's four-stage plan to reopen businesses and modify the Stay-at-Home order.

On May 26, the State announced that hair salons and barber shops can now re-open with modifications in Counties approved for accelerated re-opening. The County of Orange was approved by the State of California to accelerate re-opening.

### Businesses that Can Open with Modifications

- Hair Salons & Barber Shops
- In-Person Dining Reservations
- Places of Worship
- Retail Shopping, with social distancing and curbside pickup
- Manufacturing
- Offices ( when telework not possible)
- Tanning Facilities
- Pet Groomers
- Car Washes
- Landscaping Gardening
- Outdoor Museums

Before re-opening, businesses must perform the following modifications:

1. Perform a detailed risk assessment and implement a site-specific protection plan
2. Train employees on how to limit the spread of COVID-19, including how to screen themselves for symptoms and stay home if they have them
3. Implement individual control measures and screenings
4. Implement disinfecting protocols
5. Implement physical distancing guidelines
