### Brea Police Department Seeks Public Assistance in Identifying Person of Interest

Brea, Calif. – On March 8, 2022 at approximately 2:50 PM, an upper-grade Country Hills Elementary School student was contacted by an adult male subject in the area of County Hills Park, near Wandering Lane and Rainbow Lane. The student, who was not harmed, ran from the male subject. Police officers quickly responded, but were unable to locate the subject.
