In this packet you will find the league application, roster forms, league rules and regulations, along with important dates.

League Fees

- **TOTAL UPFRONT FOR Fall 2021 - \$730 (11 game season)**
- **\$400 league fee and full season referee fees - Must be paid at the time of registration. NO CASH OR CHECK PAYMENT. Credit Card ONLY.**
- **\$30.00 / game referee fee** - This fee is used to pay the scheduled official for each game. Must be paid at the time of registration. This amount will likely differ from season to season, as number of games played per season may fluctuate. Playoff game referee fees will be charged to the credit card used for original registration the day after playoff games are played. NO CASH OR CHECK PAYMENT. Credit Card ONLY.

Registration

- League play is on Sunday nights at the Brea Community Center.
- Game start times may range between 3:00pm-9:00pm on Sunday nights depending on number of teams in the league.
- League officials reserve the right to move teams to another league based on level of play.
- **This season can be between 10 and 12 games.**

Forfeits

1. If a team forfeits, the forfeiting team will be charged for the other teams' \$30.00 referee fee the following day using the credit card on file.
 - The team who was forfeited against will then receive a \$30.00 refund, which can be done as a credit card refund, or placed as a credit on the manager's Brea Recreation account.
2. **Teams forfeiting two or more times during a season will not be allowed to priority register and will be placed on a waiting list for the next season, and possibly**

Roster Information

1. Rosters are limited to a maximum of 12 players.
2. **Must include player's name, address, phone number, and signature.**
3. Players must be at least 18 years of age.
4. **No player shall play for two different teams in the same division in the City of Brea.**
5. Each team will be permitted to add or drop a total of four players before the 4th league game.
 - Once a player is removed from a roster he may not be re-added.
 - Roster changes must be submitted prior to the 4th league game on the form provided in order to be eligible for the playoffs.

Uniforms

1. Must be of matching color and have at least 6-inch numbers on the back.
 - Any team not meeting this league rule may be charged with a technical foul.
 - Taped or written numbers are not acceptable.
2. All players must wear rubber-soled non-marking shoes.

League Standings/Awards

1. The number of teams in each division will determine what type of championship game will be played, it may be a tournament or broken down into halves with the winners playing each other.
 - If one team wins both halves, no playoff will take place.
 - If two teams are tied, overall record or head to head play will determine round winners.
2. Individual awards will be given to the championship team members in each league. Awards will be given only to the players on final roster.

Rules and Regulations

Rules are based on the National Federation of State High School Rule Book with the addition of applicable City League Rules.

Team Players

1. A team must have four players to start a game. If a team does not have four players at game time:
 - The game clock will start and one point per minute will be awarded to the opposing team up to the time the official calls a forfeit at the 10-minute mark.
 - If and when the team's fourth player arrives and is on the court ready to play, the game clock will stop and jump ball will start the game with the time remaining in the first half.
 - A team may not call a time out during this 10-minute period.
 - Every player must play in at least one league game each round in order to be eligible for playoffs.

Game Format

1. Game time is as scheduled.
2. The official time and score shall be maintained by the timer/scorekeeper.
3. Managers are responsible for giving the scorekeeper their lineup and advising them of any changes.
4. All players requesting a substitution must first report verbally to the scorer's table with sufficient time before the next dead ball.
5. The substituted player must remain at the table until the time of substitution. The player who is being substituted out must exit near the scorer's table.
6. The game will consist of two 20 minutes halves.
7. Half time will be two minutes.
8. The game clock will run continuously except for time outs, or during the last two minutes of the game under the following conditions:
 - If the score difference is more than 10 points the clock will run continuously.
 - If the score difference is 10 points or less, the clock will become regulation (stop clock).
 - The clock will become regulation (stop clock) at any time during the final two minutes of the game as long as the score difference is 10 points or less.
 - If at any time during the last two minutes of the game the score difference becomes more than 10 points, the clock will run continuously.
 - After a time-out is called, the clock will not restart until a player in bound touches the ball.
 - If free throws are shot immediately after a time-out, the clock will not restart until a player touches the rebound or inbound pass.
9. If the score is tied at the end of regulation play, a three-minute overtime period will be played with a stopped clock for the last minute. One time out per team. Team fouls carry over.
10. If the score remains tied at the end of the overtime period, a second overtime period will be played and the winner will be determined by the first team to score five points. (No clock, no time outs, no fouls to give).

Technical Fouls/Ejections

1. The clock will stop on all technical fouls and will not be restarted until the ball is put back into play.
2. All technical fouls are both a team and personal foul.
3. An intentional foul is not a technical foul therefore the clock will continue to run.
4. Any player receiving a technical foul must sit on the bench for a two-minute period of game time immediately after receiving a technical foul.
5. Two technical fouls charged to the same player or coach in one game will result in immediate ejection from the game.
 - A player, coach/team manager or spectator who is ejected from the game must leave the gym immediately.
 - Failure to leave the gym immediately will result in a forfeit of the current game.
 - All ejections from a game shall result in suspension from the next scheduled league game(s) and the facility.
 - The manager will receive a written notice regarding the penalty.
6. Three technical fouls in the course of one season may result in a game suspension or further disciplinary action, including expulsion from the league.
7. All ejections are subject to review and may result in further suspensions or expulsions for the league depending on the severity of the infraction.
8. If the team manager is ejected, the game will be forfeited.
9. If an ejection leads to a team having only 3 players, that team forfeits.

Headgear/Jewelry

1. It is illegal to wear headgear equipment that could cause injury to other players.
2. Headgear is interpreted to mean hats or bandannas. A one-piece sweatband of soft pliable material is permissible.
3. Only flat wedding bands are allowed

City of Brea Sportsmanship Policy (Please Read and Sign)

Sportsmanship

1. The City of Brea rates sportsmanship high in our leagues.
2. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Players may be ejected without warning for unsportsmanlike conduct.
3. Profanity, liquor or smoking will not be tolerated in or about the gym or within the parking facility.
 - Abuse of these rules may result in a forfeit of the game and/or a team suspension from the league.
 - Use of profanity will result in a technical foul. Should the official be unable to determine which of the individual players used profanity, but can determine the team, a team technical will be assessed.
4. Any unsportsmanlike conduct by players, coaches, or fans may result in ejection and or forfeit of the game.
5. Staff and officials are here to assist you. Please treat them with respect.
 - Verbal or physical abuse of the staff, officials, coaches, players or spectators will result in immediate ejection from the game/league.
 - Ongoing problems with players and/or teams may result in suspension or expulsion from participation in the City of Brea's adult sports leagues.
6. Any fights/physical altercations may result in disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the league.

Manager's Responsibilities to City of Brea Basketball League

1. It is the manager's responsibility to turn in a roster to City of Brea adult sports staff before the first game of the season. City of Brea staff will provide a roster sheet on site at the time of the first game if a roster has not been completed and submitted by the manager. Failure to submit a roster on time may result in forfeiture of future games and suspension of the team without a refund of fees paid.
2. Changes or additions to the team roster must be submitted immediately by the team manager to City of Brea Adult Basketball staff. The last opportunity for a manager to make a change to the team roster is prior to the start of the fourth game of the regular season. No changes or additions may be made to the team roster after the start of the fourth regular league game. Failure to notify Brea staff immediately of changes, or if changes are made during and/or after game four of the regular season may result in player disqualification and forfeiture of any games in which the individual participated.
3. Managers are fully responsible for the conduct of their players and fans at all times. It is the responsibility of the manager to share the City of Brea Sportsmanship Policy with each of their players, and ensure that each player has read and understands the Policy. Non-compliance may result in game suspension, dismissal, or permanent expulsion from Brea Adult Athletic League play.
