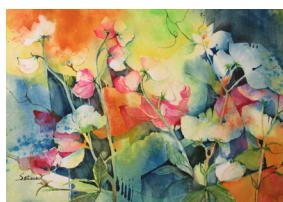


Keiko Tanabe

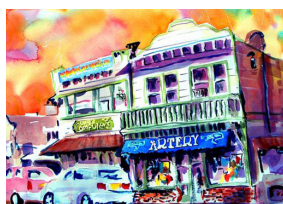


Setsuko Okubo

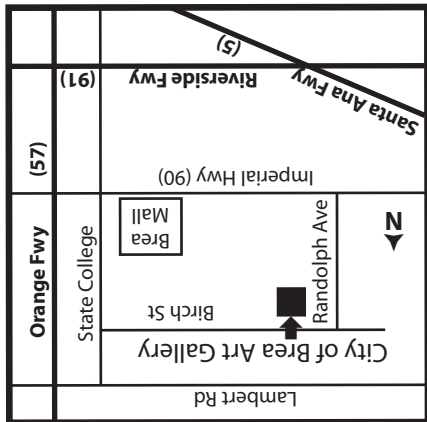
